## RULES

1. Anyone from any town or county may enter, there is no entry fee.
2. Exhibitors may enter as many exhibits as they wish, but only (1) one entry per class. You cannot have more than one entry in a class.
3. Entry must be entered in name of person who created it.
4. Entries that have been judged before will not be judged.
5. Canning exhibits should be labeled, dated, and in a regulation canning jar. Jar will not be opened for judging
6. In the baking category, a whole cake, pie, or loaf of bread should be brought for judging. A large piece will be cut for judging, the remainder of the item will be returned to the exhibitor at time of entry.
7. Pies will be judged whole and the remainder of the pie donated to the Fair Board Food Building. Pie crusts must be homemade, not already prepared. No cream pies will be judged.
8. Brownies, cookies, candy, muffins, decorated cupcakes, and yeast rolls should be 4 on a plate.
