1st - \$5.00, 2nd - \$2.50, 3rd - \$1.50
- Adolescent:** Ages 13 through 18.
1st - \$10.00, 2nd - \$8.00, 3rd - \$5.00
- Adult-Student:** Age 19 or older, non-professional.
- Adult-Professional:** Age 19 or older who teaches or has sold at least 3 works of art in the last year.
1st - \$10.00, 2nd - \$8.00, 3rd - \$5.00
